Directions to Rancho Cordova Neighborhood Center:

Eastbound Hwy. 50 - Take Highway 50 to the Mather Field exit and go north over the freeway. Turn right (west) onto Folsom Boulevard. Drive to Coloma Road and turn left (north). The Rancho Cordova Neighborhood Center is located in the parking lot on the left side at 10665 Coloma Road.

Westbound Hwy. 50 - Take Highway 50 to the Mather Field exit and turn right (north) off the exit. Proceed to Folsom Boulevard and turn right (west). Drive to Coloma Road and turn left (north). The Rancho Cordova Neighborhood Center is located in the parking lot on the left side at 10665 Coloma Road.
