

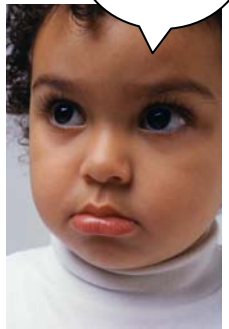


Gosh, Mom, we could get child care!

How to Get Subsidized Child Care

If you are receiving cash aid and participating in a Welfare to Work activity with the Department of Human Assistance (DHA), ask your worker to send a referral for child care to Child Action, Inc. (CAI). You will be enrolled on CAI's Stage 1 program.

If you were on cash aid within the last 24 months and are no longer aided, you could be eligible for CAI's Stage 2 program. If you think you are eligible, please call (916-361-0511) to apply.

If you have never been on cash aid or it's been longer than 24 months, you can call the CEL (916-369-0191) or go online at thecel.net to apply for services.

Stage 1 Child Care

- DHA* You must be on cash aid.
- DHA* You must be referred to CAI by your County worker.
- DHA* Your County worker will determine your eligibility.
- DHA* Your provider must sign paperwork for the County.
- DHA* You or your provider must request reimbursement from the County for payment. You can get the form from the County or CAI or online at dhaweb.saccounty.net/financial/childcare.html
- DHA* The County will pay your provider.

Stage 2 or CAPP Child Care

- CAI* You can be on cash aid or not.
- CAI* You can call CAI directly. See the phone numbers above.
- CAI* CAI will determine your eligibility.
- CAI* Your provider must complete an enrollment on CAI's program.
- CAI* You or your provider must submit a CAI Attendance Form to CAI (The form will be sent to your provider before each month of care.)
- CAI* CAI will pay your provider.
