## What do I need to bring with me to my tax appointment?

*The following items are needed to  
prepare your tax return:*

- Driver's license or Photo I.D.
- Social Security Card or Individual Tax  
Identification Number (ITIN) for all  
members in your family
- All W-2 forms
- If filing jointly, your spouse must be  
present
- Copy of prior year tax return  
(if applicable)
- 1099 Forms (if applicable)

**Are you eligible for the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)?**

Families and individuals who worked in 2009 may be eligible for the EITC. If your earned income and adjusted gross income (AGI) was less than:

- \$43,279 (\$48,279 if married filing jointly) with three or more children;
- \$40,295 (\$45,295 if married filing jointly) for families with two children;
- \$35,463 (\$40,463 if married filing jointly) if there is one child
- \$13,440 (\$18,440 if married filing jointly) if no children

**Tax Year 2009 maximum credit:**

- \$5,657 for a family with three or more children;
- \$5,028 for a family with two children;
- \$3,043 for a family with one child;
- \$455 if there are no children

**Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)**

There are certified tax preparers who will do your taxes for free through the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program. You are eligible for this free service if your household income was \$49,000 or less in 2009. Multi-lingual assistance is available. Please call 2-1-1 Sacramento and ask for a VITA site near you.

Based on your annual earnings, you may be eligible to receive the earned income tax credit from the federal government. The earned income tax credit is a refundable income tax credit for low-income working individuals and families. The earned income tax credit has no effect on certain welfare benefits. In most cases, earned income tax credit payments will not be used to determine eligibility for Medicaid, supplemental security income, food stamps, low-income housing or most temporary assistance for needy families payments. Even if you do not owe federal taxes, you must file a tax return to receive the earned income tax credit. Be sure to fill out the earned income tax credit form in the federal income tax return booklet. For information regarding your eligibility to receive the earned income tax credit, including information on how to obtain the IRS notice 797 or form W-5, or any other necessary forms and instructions, contact the internal revenue service by calling 1-800-829-3676 or through its website at [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov).
